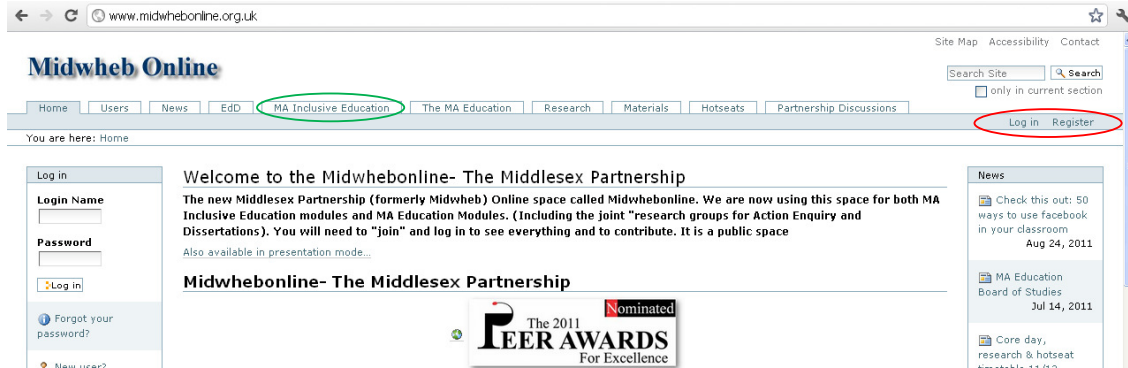


Creating an account and accessing your folder on www.midwhebonline.org.uk

Below is a screenshot of the midwhebonline home page.



- The green circle above highlights the tabs for the different sections of the site. For example, MA Inclusive students will find there course materials by clicking on the circled “MA Inclusive Education” tab.
- Material on the site is public, but to receive your own folder and contribute to activities on your programme you will need an account. The red circle gives you the options to log in or register.
- Below you can see a screenshot of the registration page:

This step is straightforward and once you have registered you will be logged in. If you are not logged in automatically then please log in manually by clicking ‘Log in’ (this is highlighted by the red circle in the second screenshot).

Once logged in you will see your name and folder (highlighted by the blue circle).

- The ‘Add new’ option highlighted by the purple circle gives you the options to add new folders, pages, images and other files. We recommend you develop a coherent folder system that will make it easy for you to store your files and share them with your tutors.

However, other users of the site will only be able to see public files. Please note that sometimes it may be useful to make files public, this may be the case when you work in collaboration or when you want to share materials with peers.
